History of Nursing in India

The history of nursing in India spans from ancient practices to modern, formalized education and practice



While informal care existed in ancient times, formal nursing education and practice began during the British colonial period, with the establishment of the first nursing schools and the influence of Florence Nightingale. The profession has evolved significantly since India's independence, with the establishment of regulatory bodies like the Indian Nursing Council and the expansion of nursing education at various levels.

First Nursing Schools:

The first formal nursing school was established in Madras (now Chennai) in 1871, offering a six-month diploma program.

British Influence:

The British government played a crucial role in establishing nursing schools and training programs throughout the late 19th and early 20th centuries.

Nursing Associations:

The Trained Nurses Association of India (TNAI) was founded in 1908, advocating for nurses' rights and promoting education.

Post-Independence Era:

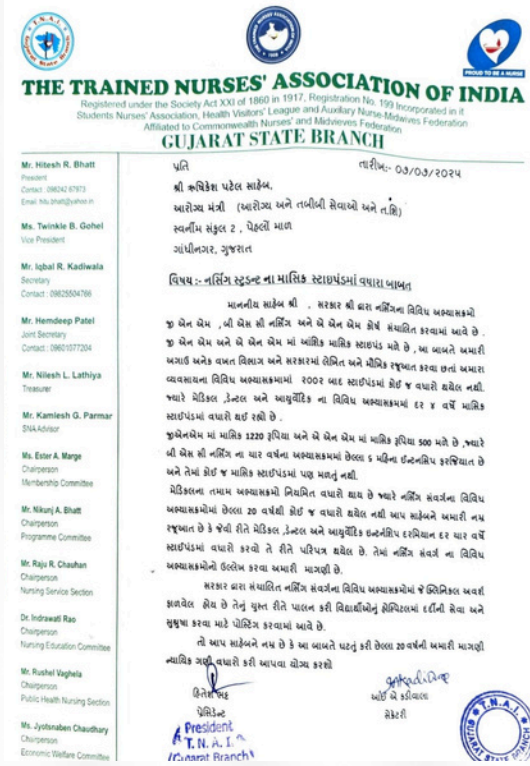
Following India's independence in 1947, the Indian Nursing Council (INC) was established in 1947 to regulate nursing education and practice, setting standards for training and registration.

Expansion of Education:

Nursing education expanded with the introduction of degree programs (BSc, MSc) and the integration of nursing education into the university system. Nursing in India has continued to evolve with the development of various nursing programs (ANM, GNM, BSc, MSc, etc.) and the establishment of regulatory bodies like the INC and TNAI.

Development of a training system for virtual reality trauma first aid nursing teamwork in central China Award



Virtual reality training can save resources and improve training efficiency. The cooperation of trauma team can shorten the treatment time and improve the treatment efficiency.

Method:

This study employed a quasi-experimental design to evaluate standardized trauma team performance scores among emergency nurses following VR training. Participants included 68 emergency department nurses from a tertiary Grade A hospital in Wuhan, China, who were divided into 17 groups (4 members per group) through convenience sampling. All teams underwent training using a virtual reality training system developed by the research team. Paired-sample t-tests were conducted to compare differences in standardized trauma team performance scores across all 17 groups between pre-intervention (March-May 2023) and post-intervention (September-November 2023) periods. Subsequently, qualitative research was implemented using semi-structured interviews to capture participants' experiential feedback regarding the VR training system.

Result :-

Compared to traditional training, the use of the VR training system resulted in significantly enhanced teamwork performance among emergency nurses during simulated trauma first aid scenarios. Interview results indicated that the system's novel format deepened professional understanding, conserved resources, increased practice opportunities, and enhanced the efficiency of trauma first aid nursing training. Moreover, it facilitated multi-role experiences, facilitating teamwork exercises.

UMass Memorial Health has expanded its use of an AI tool to support nurses conducting ED discharge through clinical decision support and early identification of urgent care needs.

UMass Memorial Health is expanding its use of an AI tool designed to support ED nurses tasked with patient triage. Effective triage is critical in an ED, where medical concerns can range from the trivial to the deadly. However, as ED boarding and overcrowding worsen, health outcomes may suffer, with one study showing that peak ED overcrowding increased mortality risk by more than 5%. | **ED - Emergency Department**

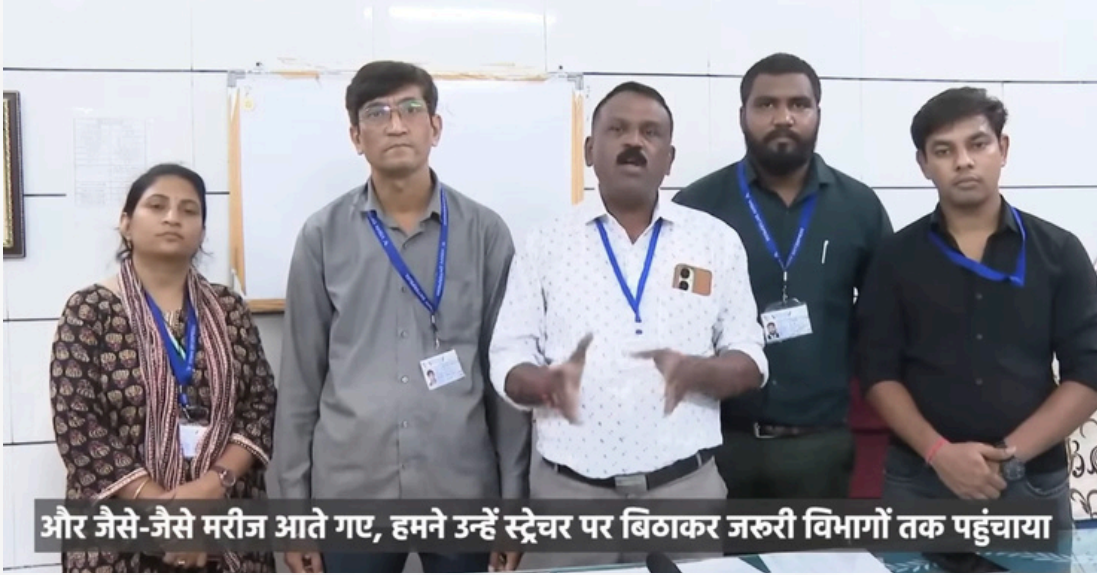

India Awarded WHO Certificate for Eliminating Trachoma

On 20th May 2025, at the 78th World Health Assembly in Geneva, the WHO awarded India the Certificate of Elimination of Trachoma as a Public Health Problem, recognizing its efforts in disease elimination and preventive healthcare.

National Zero Measles-Rubella Elimination Campaign



On 24th April 2025, Union Minister for Health, launched the National Zero Measles-Rubella (MR) Elimination Campaign to achieve the goal of eliminating Measles and Rubella by 2026, marking the beginning of World Immunization Week.

Campaign Launch: Virtually launched, the MR Elimination Campaign will run from 2025 to 2026.

Awareness Drive: Multilingual IEC materials, including posters, radio jingles, and campaign films, will be distributed across all States and Union Territories to increase public participation.

Immunization Target: The goal is to achieve 100% immunization coverage, ensuring no child is left behind in preventing these highly contagious diseases.

Progress Achieved: As of March 2025, 332 districts reported zero measles cases, and 487 reported zero rubella cases.
